

## **All Courts in Gregg County Texas** **Dress Code**

This uniform Dress Code shall be applicable in any District, County Court at Law or County Courtroom in Gregg County. Each Judge shall determine how the code will be enforced, including contempt proceedings against any person appearing in violation. Each judge may determine dress code for his or her clerks and court staff.

### **Attorneys:**

Males- Men are to wear a dress shirt with buttons and hem tucked in. Men shall wear business jackets and ties.

Females- Women shall wear a suit, dress with business jacket, skirt and blouse with a business jacket, pant suit or dress slacks with a business jacket.

If probation officers, legal assistants or lawyer staff appear in the courtroom before the bar, or sit at counsel table, they will abide by the same rules as attorneys do.

It is suggested that it is not appropriate to wear shorts, athletic shoes or sneakers, or flip-flops. Sleeveless shirts or T-shirts with writing, other than a county or state emblem, are not appropriate. Garments showing cleavage, see-thru garments, and skirt lengths substantially above the knee are not appropriate. Backless tops, spaghetti straps, tank tops, halter tops, exposed midriffs, or other tight or provocative tops are not appropriate.

Note: If an employee of Gregg County has another dress code in effect for his or her office, the stricter of the two shall apply in court.
